

REWARD SYSTEM

Our aim is to create a school climate in which all students feel 'it's cool' to achieve in all aspects of school participation.

Awards are an essential element in each student's Record of Achievement.

(a) Junior Students

Each Thursday or Friday. Year 9 and 10 students will gain a merit if they have:

- ❖ been punctual
- ❖ brought all correct gear
- ❖ completed homework
- ❖ had a good attitude and tried hard
- ❖ Teachers will sign the sheet printed in the diary.

One responsible student will be selected by the Dean to give teachers a gentle reminder to award merits as appropriate.

Students will receive awards as listed below:

Tutor's Award	20 Merits
Dean's Award	40 Merits
Principal's Award	80 Merits
Principal's Award with distinction	120 Merits
Board of Trustees Award	200 Merits
Board of Trustees Award with Distinction	280 Merits



1. For Dean and Principal's Award

3. For Board of Trustees and BOT with Distinction Awards
 - ❖ Letter sent home
 - ❖ Students to receive at Junior Prizegiving

(b) Senior Students

Years 11 to 13 students will receive subject merits each term as per the junior criteria. The lists will be finalised by the Administration Dean in consultation with the Deans.

Students receiving merits in all subjects throughout the year will receive a special merit award at the Senior Prizegiving.

(c) All Students can gain further range of rewards

- ❖ Attendance draws for perfect fortnightly attendance. One senior and one junior student is randomly selected and given a \$5.00 canteen voucher.
- ❖ Attendance Certificates are awarded at the end of each Term for excellent attendance (2 or less 1/2 days absent).
- ❖ Chance Cards are awarded for individual, excellent work. Teachers must sign the card, write the student's name and ask the student to place it in the box in the office. Five students (3 juniors and 2 seniors) will be selected in a fortnightly draw for a canteen voucher.
- ❖ Certificate of Citizenship is gained by a student who displayed an act of good citizenship. Names are passed to the Principal for action.
